

Teaching Vacancies for Summer School Programme

The Politics and Security Programme of the OSCE Academy in Bishkek is looking for several short-term Lecturers for its pilot, three-week long Summer School programme. The Summer School is designed for newly accepted MA students of the OSCE Academy as a preparatory programme as well as for other eligible applicants from Central Asia, Afghanistan and Mongolia, who wish to broaden their knowledge and skills on “Academic Writing and Honesty” and “Introduction to Research Methods in Social Science”.

The OSCE Academy in Bishkek is looking for two Lecturers, who can teach course on “Academic Writing and Honesty” and one lecturer to teach “Introduction to Research Methods in Social Science”. Teaching will be conducted between 13 August 2018 and 31 August 2018.

These courses are expected to be taught as introductory graduate level courses. Specific course duties as well as course design should be further discussed with the academic management of the OSCE Academy once selected.

Requirements:

- MA degree, PhD candidate or PhD degree in Social Sciences
- Relevant teaching experience
- Excellent command of academic English
- Effective interpersonal and communication skills

Honorarium and benefits:

600 euros (gross) per 1 credit. Each course is worth of 2 credits (30 academic hours).
